- Student must demonstrate academic ability and maturity to participate in a college level course, and with the necessary proficiency in English, as determined by the principal, or their designee.
- Student must submit a high school transcript.
- Student must demonstrate their interest in taking a class at Tufts in the form of a letter or essay. This letter or essay should indicate at least one class that the student has an interest in taking.
- Student must demonstrate a financial need for scholarship, to be determined at the discretion of the Medford/Somerville High School principal or their designee.
